## Zero Tolerance Policy

Geneva Parks & Recreation is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and family-friendly environment for all programs, teams, games, practices, events, activities, and facilities.

The following behavior is not allowed and may result in immediate removal and/or suspension from future activities:

- Fighting or physical violence
- Threats, intimidation, harassment, or bullying
- Disorderly, disruptive, or unsafe conduct
- Property damage, vandalism, or stealing
- Trespassing or entering restricted areas
- Weapons of any kind
- Alcohol, illegal drugs, or drug use
- Abusive, vulgar, or inappropriate language
- Verbal abuse toward staff, officials, coaches, players, or spectators
- Any behavior that creates an unsafe or negative environment

Geneva Parks & Recreation staff, supervisors, officials, and authorized representatives have the authority to remove any person who violates this policy or disrupts the safety and enjoyment of others.

The City of Geneva Parks & Recreation Department may refuse entry, remove individuals, suspend participants, parents, coaches, spectators, volunteers, or other individuals, and update policies as needed.

Law enforcement may be contacted when necessary.

These rules exist to protect children, families, staff, officials, volunteers, and the community.
